- First Stop will be the new Magic Wings Butterfly Conservatory and Gardens in South Deerfield, MA. This delightful place is dedicated to the creation and preservation of butterflies and moths. We will have an introduction by one of their trained tour guides followed by a leisurely stroll through the 4000 square foot glass conservatory with over 300 native and tropical butterflies and moths.
- Lunch will be at the charming, historic Deerfield Inn. Entrees include a choice of Fettuccine Alfredo, Boston baked scrod with lobster sauce or Grilled rib-eye steak with mushroom bordelaise.
- Our final stop will be a visit to Stanley Park in Westfield. There you will have a choice of a leisurely walk through the Wildlife Sanctuary or a guided tour through several of the formal gardens. The Sanctuary has 160 acres of managed trails and land with native trees, wildflowers ferns and more. A haven for area birds and wildlife, accessed through raised wooden boardwalks and bridges. The formal gardens include The Rose Garden with over 50 varieties of roses and 2,500 rose bushes and the Japanese Garden where rare and unusual exotic plantings surround the Japanese Tea House.
