<u>Sun. April 15</u> – Culver Pond – 10:00 AM - Explore the latest Land Trust acquisition. Culver Pond is a 118 acre parcel of land in Stafford, near the Somers town line. We'll hike the rolling hills of the property, about four miles, approximately a two to three hour hike. Bring binoculars for spring birding opportunities. <u>Sat. April 28</u> - Sunset / Moonlight at Skyline – 7:00 PM - moonrise at 7:27, sunset at 7:45. We will hike around Trust's 65 acre Skyline Scenic Area on Stafford Rd near Somers/Stafford line. We will enjoy the sunset and beautiful view across valley towards Springfield from atop the mountain, have a snack if you would like to bring one, then return by the light of the moon. <u>Sat., May 5</u> – Canoe and Kayak Paddle of Upper Bolton Lake in Vernon -Take a leisurely tour of this pristine lake setting, perfect for bird-watching, photo opportunities, or just a quiet morning enjoying the outdoors. Sun. May 13 - Mother's Day hike on McCann Family Farm - 10:00 AM. Comfortable trail walk thru field and forest. Good birdwatching habitat. Mothers bring the kids – kids bring your mother! Sat. June 2 - Trails Weekend - 10:00 AM - We will follow blazed trails through the Land Trust's premier 200+ acre, Whitaker Woods property, featuring woodland and a cow pasture. This approximately 5 mile, one way hike will be scenic, with bridge crossings and beautifully constructed and well preserved stone walls. There will be the opportunity to loop back to the trail head for a shorter hike. From the Land Trust property we will continue on Somers Trail Committee and Shenipsit State Forest trails to the Soapstone Mountain Lookout. There will be transportation back to the trail head. We will discuss the natural and land use history as well as local wildlife along the way. Meet behind the Somers Town Hall, 600 Main St., Rt. 190, near the intersection of Rt. 83 in the center of Somers. We will car pool to the trailhead. Sat. June 16 - Hike at Ernie Boothroyd Preserve, Ellington. - 10:00 AM. The 58 acre Ernie Boothroyd Preserve was acquired by NCLT in 2010. This will be an easy 1.2 mile walk with stops to look at and discuss items of interest. Directions: From the junction of Rte. 140 and Tolland Ave. in Stafford Springs take Tolland Ave south for 1.5 miles. The Boothroyd Preserve is on the right. If coming from the south; from the Tolland Green take Old Stafford Road (becomes Tolland Turnpike) 4.8 miles north to Ernie Boothroyd Preserve on the left. Sun. Sept. 23 - Bald Mtn. Preserve, Somers - 10:00 AM – We will hike through two Land Trust properties as well as Town of Somers and State of CT properties. These comprise the Bald Mountain Preserve, which includes the entire summit of the tallest of the surrounding mountains. Foliage should be starting to turn. The trails are steep and rocky in some places but not difficult with good shoes. The distance will be about 2 1/2 miles. <u>Sat., Sept. 29</u> - The 6th Annual Talcottville Gorge/Falls and Vernon Rail Trail circular hike. Sun., October 14 – Fall foliage along Railroad Brook gorge in Vernon. Hike thru the Trust's Andrew Webster Knapp property to the Rails-to-trails, then up to the ridge overlooking Valley Falls Park and Railroad Brook for some beautiful scenery. Sat. Dec. 15 – Schlaf Farm, Somers. Hike 2.5 miles at a casual pace exploring a 38 acre property conserved by the Northern CT Land Trust located in the picturesque center of Somers, CT. The hike follows easy navigable woodland trails with few gentle inclines and skirts a cornfield. If there is snow, hikers may plan to bring cross-country skis, snowshoes, or a sled to pull along the little ones. Leashed dogs are welcome.
