

### TREASURER'S REPORT

### Fiscal Year Ending July 31, 2022

The net worth of the NCLT increased by \$21,222 in the past year due primarily to contributions from our members and friends.

This year, the NCLT improved the Nipmuck Woods property by installing a parking area at the entrance to the property. This improvement provides dedicated parking to our members and friends who enjoy the property and its trails. Also, the NCLT expanded the parking area at McCann to allow for additional parking. In addition to the parking area improvements at Nipmuck Woods and McCann, NCLT added additional signage to multiple NCLT-owned properties to improve the identification of the property and trailheads.

In addition to the improvements noted above, the NCLT continues its planning to construct a robust trail with durable boardwalks, bridges and a viewing station that will provide access for hiking, fishing and wildlife observing at our Scantic River Riparian Area (SRA) property. The NCLT has owned the 48-acre Scantic River Riparian Area in Somers, CT for 19 years. The SRA is in the flood plain of the Scantic River and significant flooding over the years has washed away our original trail system. This project is made possible by a \$20,000 challenge contribution received in fiscal year ending July 31, 2021. Contributions made by the NCLT's members and friends will be matched from the Scantic River Riparian Area Trail Fund to provide the money needed to construct this trail.

With the support of our members and friends, your all-volunteer NCLT has accomplished a great deal since its beginning in 1987.


